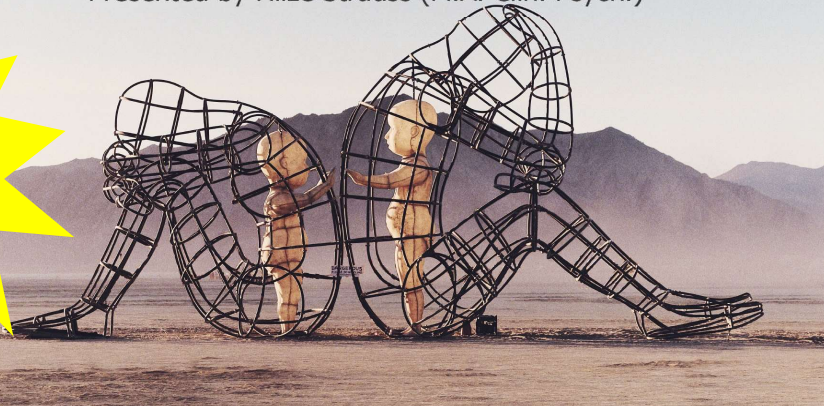

A step by step process to help couples re-pair after the trauma of an affair.

This two-day training addresses the three challenges therapists face when working with couples that have undergone the trauma of an affair:
